LAH Invests \$2.5 million in Facility Upgrades

WINSLOW, Maine (Jan. 23, 2008) -- To better meet customer needs, Lohmann Animal Health (LAH) has invested \$2.5 million in facility upgrades within the last year.

Included in the improvements is the addition of a new state-of-the-art distribution center to the company's production site. The distribution center's cooler alone is 60 feet wide by 80 feet long with 20 foot ceilings and affords the ability to hold product in levels high enough to accommodate increasing market demand.

An additional harvest laboratory also has been added to Lohmann's production facility. With the constant demand of product, the laboratory will support increased vaccine production.

A new eight room isolation unit for avian service testing purposes also has been built and is in use. October marked the first serials to be completed in the new facility. Turkey hatching facilities will also be added to enable greater accessibility to turkeys for testing procedures.

A training center has been added, fully equipped with its own kitchen, restroom and storage space. The center has wireless internet capability, projectors and podiums. The facility accommodates large groups and can be used for visitor presentations, internal meetings and employee training.

"These additions are evidence of the LAH commitment to provide our poultry customers with the best avian vaccines available," said Dave Zacek, LAH president and CEO.
